About this Document

This document contains the notes for the release of activePDF WebGrabber version 3.5.2 service pack 7 (SP7), which includes a list of included fixes and instructions for installing the service pack.

Fixes

The following issue has been fixed in WebGrabber SP7:

- Fixed an issue in which the activePDF WebGrabber IE Engine stops working after the installation of Windows® Server 2003 SP1.

Installing WebGrabber SP7

In order to install activePDF WebGrabber SP7, you will need to install activePDF Server™ 3.5.2 SP7, which is available for download from www.activePDF.com. Once activePDF Server SP7 is installed, please refer to the following instructions.

To install activePDF WebGrabber SP7:

1. Log on as a Local Administrator.
2. Download the necessary file from **www.activePDF.com**.
NOTE: You may be prompted to enter your member logon information before beginning the download.
3. Close any open applications.
4. Click **Start > Run**, type **services.msc /s**, and then click **OK**.
5. Right-click the **Print Spooler** service, and then click **Restart**.

NOTE: Restarting the Print Spooler service will restart all system-printing processes.

6. Click **Start > Run**, type **X:\apwbgrb352sp7.exe** (substitute the appropriate location), and then click **OK**.
7. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation.
8. Restart your machine.

Assigning the WGIELogin User

The WGIELogin.exe allows you to specify a user to ensure proper access when using the IE Engine. We recommend that you reassign the WGIELogin user account after the installation of SP7.

NOTE: The user specified in WGIELogin.exe must have administrative privileges on the local machine.

To assign the WGIELogin user:

1. Log on as the Local Administrator or a User account with administrative rights on the local machine.
2. Click **Start > Run**, type **services.msc /s**, and then click **OK**.
3. Right-click the **Print Spooler** service, and then click **Stop**.

NOTE: Stopping the Print Spooler service will stop all system printing processes.

4. Right-click **Start** and then click **Explore**.
5. Navigate to the **APWebGrabber** folder. If applicable, click Show all files in this folder to display any hidden files. By default, the location of this folder is **X:\Program Files\activePDF\APWebGrabber**.
6. Double-click **WGIELogin.exe**.
7. In the **Enter the domain** box, type the network domain or "." (period) for the local machine.
8. In the **Enter the UserID** box, type the Local Administrator ID or a User account with administrative rights on the local machine.
9. In the **Enter the password box**, type the password for the UserID.

10. In the second **Enter the password box**, re-type the password for the UserID, and then click **OK**.
11. Click **Start > Run**, type **services.msc /s**, and then click **OK**.
12. Right-click the **Print Spooler** service, and then click **Restart**.
